HEALTH COMMISSION:

A special Google meeting for all the Diocesian secretaries and members was organized by Most. Rt. Rev. Dr. Geogre Rajendran, Sdb, chairman on 16.05.2021 form 4.00 p.m to 6.00 p.m. 87 participants from 22 Dioceses of Tamilnadu actively participated in this virtual meeting.

Action plan:

- Parish base home care: parish priest, Volunteers, Doctors, Nurses form a committee. This committee can take a survey of affected people by COVID – 19 and Home care can be done with their consent of the family
- 2. List out the hospitals who are admitting COVID patients
- 3. Arranging Ambulances to reach the hospital
- 4. To get Oxygen beds in the hospital

- 5. Patients' attendees have to be taken care of providing cooked food and Dry rations and sanitary kits for the affected families
- 6. Psychological support to be given to the affected families.

Salem Social Service Action Plan:

- 1. To provide "CeePlus" (Vitamin D3, Vitamin C and Zinc) vitamine Tablets to all the priests of Salem.
- 2. Social support to patients in home isolation and also for persons in containment zones- Food, groceries, vegetables and other essentials.
- 3. Identification of children orphaned by covid, deaths of parents, in coordination with District Social welfare officer.
- 4. Like Pulse Polio programme , we have planned to do the auto announcement regarding vaccination site and benefits of vaccination.
- 5. IEC materials will be distributed in main places of Salem City.
