Rajamanickam, Director of SSSS and Mr. David Raja, honorary secretary of Christian Women Aid Society participated in this rights day. On this day the collector of Salem district issued the cheques worth of Rs. 4,66,000/- for 32 Catholic Christian women beneficiaries for the development of their livelihood. Rev.Fr.S.Arulappan, Suramangalam Parish Priest and Rev.Fr.Joseph Lazar requested their parishioners to donate for Christian Women Aid Society and people generously donated Rs.217000 to Christian women aid society.
