News Letter for the month of October 2021

Kolping India:

- On 25th September 2021, we organized leadership training at Thammpatti village, in Gangavalli block. 30 members from Thammampatti VLKF participated in this training.
- On 28th of September 2021 our kolping coordinator organized awareness training on water contamination at Manjakuttai village. 25 Kolping group members participated in this awareness meeting.
- On 29th of September 2021 our coordinator organized training on networking skill for Attur Kolping Federation members. 30 members participated in this training.



- On 1st of October 2021 we organized IIGP loan distribution programme for Kolping Group members in Salem region. SSSS have distributed IIGP loan amount of Rs. 1, 75, 000/- for 7 members. The members started their small business: power loom,

homemade chocolate, Petty shop, Tiffin center and fishing. Most. Rev. Dr. Arulselvam Rayappan Bishop of Salem presided over the meeting and Rev. Fr. Arulappan, VF of Salem was the chief guest of this programme. This programme was led by Rev. Fr. M. Rajamanickam Director of SSSS.

- On 11th of October 2021 SSSS organized programme fund distribution which was received from Kolping India National Office. Rev. Msgr. D. Micheal Raj Selvam, Vicar General was the Chief Guest of this programme. 37 kolping group members from Salem Region benefited through this programme.

GramaSabha meeting: October 2

- On 2nd of October 2021 our point person participated in Nagiampatti Panchayat Gramasabha meeting, 22 self help group members from uppodaiputhur village participated and have given their petitions to Panchayat leader regarding basic needs of the village.



- Our field staff Mrs. Amuthavalli participated in Thitacheri Panchayat Gramasabha meeting. Village people submitted their petition for drinking water, drainage and street light.
- Our field staff Mrs. Pappathi participated in Thalaivasal block Gramasabha meeting. Mummudi village SHG members submitted their petition for construction of Community toilet for their village. 150 members participated in this Gramasabha meeting.

- Our Field staff Mrs. Pouline participated in Thenagudipalayam Panchayat Gramashabha meeting. In this meeting the Panchayat leader explained about the importance of COVID vaccination. Vadakukadu SHG members submitted their petition for the drinking water pipeline. 62 members participated in this Gramasabha meeting.
- Our field staff Mrs. Indhara Gandhi participated in Echampatti Panchayat Gramasabha meeting. Doctors from government hospital explained about the importance of COVID vaccination and how to protect themselves from Dengue. 70 members participated in this Gramasabha meeting.



Caritas India:

- Through the support of Caritas India and Caritas Hong Kong, SSSS have provided 520 Free Medical Kits which contains (SafeHandZ plus Hand Sanitizer 500ml, VETO Liquid Hand wash 250 ml, Trueview The security systems Puls Oximeter Model i31, Control D Digital Thermometer, N95 Mask 54 and Control D Steam Vaporizer) to Frontline workers, Volunteers, All diocesan priests and Aided primary Schools in Salem Diocese.
- On 25th of September 2021 we distributed 172 medical kits to self help group leaders, Volunteers and ward members in Attur, Thalaivasal and Gangavalli blocks.
- On 28th of September 2021 we have distributed 87 medical kits to front line workers like Doctors, Nurse and Anganvadi Teachers.
- On 1st of October 2021, we distributed 148 medical kits to Media Persons and self help group members. Most. Rev. Dr. Arul Selvam Rayappan, Bishop of Salem and Rev. Fr. Arulappan VF of Salem distributed the medical kits to the participants.
- On 4th of October 2021 we have distributed 100 medical kits to Priest of Salem diocese.

On 12th of October 2021 our point person participated in RCCE monthly review meeting on virtual platform. In this meeting they have a
